5. What do you think is the significance of mentioning “enemies” at the banquet (v. 5)? Who are your enemies?
6. God does not promise to remove all the dangers or sadness of life. How, then, can we have peace and live without fear? Read John 16:33.
7. What does it mean to “dwell in the house of the Lord forever?” Is that something to experience here on earth, or just in heaven?
