

### Small Group Questions – 15.1.17

Were you / are you good at exams? Did you enjoy any training courses?

Read 1Cor 9 v24-27

What seemed important to you as you read it?

1. Bible. Do you read it regularly? Have you read it all through? What could encourage more reading of this and other helpful books?
2. Without going into a guilt spiral, how do your prayer lives vary and what ideas can you share for encouragement?
3. Do you attend St Marys? What are the benefits for (a) you, and (b) Jesus
4. I'm guessing you're a member of a small group!! Rehearse the benefits for your spiritual fitness.
5. Listening to God. How good are you at hearing God? How much does doubt inhibit you?

Bishop Ban It Chiu taught us like this:- Your leader could read this out.

It is sometimes easier to listen FOR someone else. Remember God will never say anything unloving. Choose the person opposite you across the circle. Close your eyes and ask the Holy Spirit for help. Think of a Bible story or incident. Take the first one that occurs to you and don't be tempted to discard it or think of a better one! Wait until everyone has got one. Run through it in your mind until you freeze frame or notice a particular moment. Ask God why that part is especially significant for your friend. When you share, if you are willing to, others may provide that interpretation if you are not sure. The recipient is entirely free to accept this as being from God or not.

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
