Hebrews 2: 5 - 18

What does it mean to you that the Church is the family of God? How does it shape your approach to church?

Read Psalm 8 from which the quote in vs 6-8 comes. What does it mean that God has put everything under our feet? How do we discharge that duty? What do we do with the realisation that not everything is subject yet (v. 8b)?
