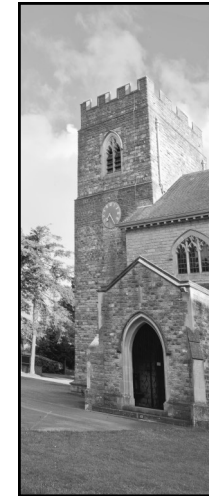

PRAYER FOCUS
