The service will be led by the Rt. Rev. Karen Gorham (Bishop of Sherborne).

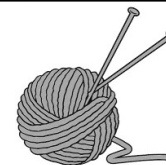
The service will be followed by refreshments at Hampreston First School. *All welcome!*

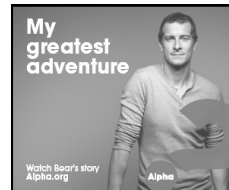
Ministry in Wool - An opportunity to knit and chat. You can bring your own project but wool, patterns and projects will be available for schools, infants and the elderly.
