This Tues, 20th Sept at 2pm in the Church Lounge

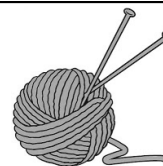
Are you suffering from a 'doing' overload, your days filled with an endless succession of jobs and activities? Then Breathing Space is for you!

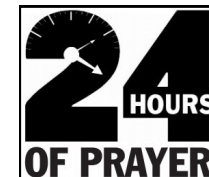
G-Force in the Hall; 3:16 in the Beacon Café

Anna-Rose Deller will be speaking on 'Living in revival' and sharing some of her experiences over the summer of seeing God at work in Mozambique and Mexico.

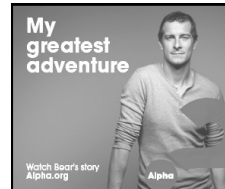
24 Hour Prayer Event Sat 24th Sept
