The roles in the café are:-

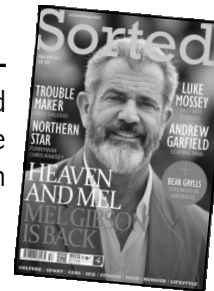
Barista (making the drinks)
