Chosen: Gideon

Read Judges 6: 1 – 32 (Quite a long passage but it's such a great story! I would encourage you all to read the whole of chapters 6 and 7)

1. What can you relate to in the story of Gideon?
2. In what ways do you sometimes feel weak and ill-equipped to do what God is calling you to do?
3. How did God encourage Gideon?
4. How does can the word of God encourage you to see the truth about who you are in Christ? Can you think of any verses of Scripture that demonstrate this? (e.g. 1 Thess. 5: 24; 1 John 4: 4; Phil. 4: 13; Eph. 1: 19, 20; Rom. 8: 11 etc.)
5. Can you share any stories of when you have stepped out in obedience despite your fears – when courage was needed? What did you learn from that experience?

Pray for each other this week, that the Lord will give you courage and help you to trust him and be obedient to His calling. Look for opportunities to bring His hope and light into the situations you encounter. When you next meet share stories of how it has been.
