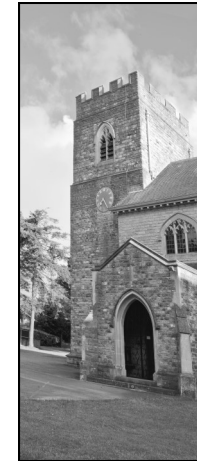

The cost is £10 per person.

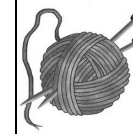
This will be a really fun event run by Paul Hartley and Paul Craddock (our 2 top chefs who both have Michelin star backgrounds).
