Important Drainage Works Tues 1st August - Fri 18th August inclusive - Hall corridor and toilets access affected

As you may or may not know, we have been experiencing ongoing problems with the waste water pump system installed in the hall corridor to service the cafe. The best long-term solution is to connect the cafe drains to the main drains underground in the ladies' toilets and following investigation this has been confirmed as viable.

We have therefore instructed JM Scully (our building contractor who oversaw The Beacon Project) to undertake this work but this will mean that the hall corridor and toilets will not be accessible on weekdays from Tues 1st August to Fri 18th August, inclusive. Portaloo (including a disabled Portaloo) will be provided and will be sited just outside the patio area in front of the cafe. There is also a toilet and baby change facility available in the vestry area.
