A time to be still and enjoy sitting in silence in God's presence *All welcome*.

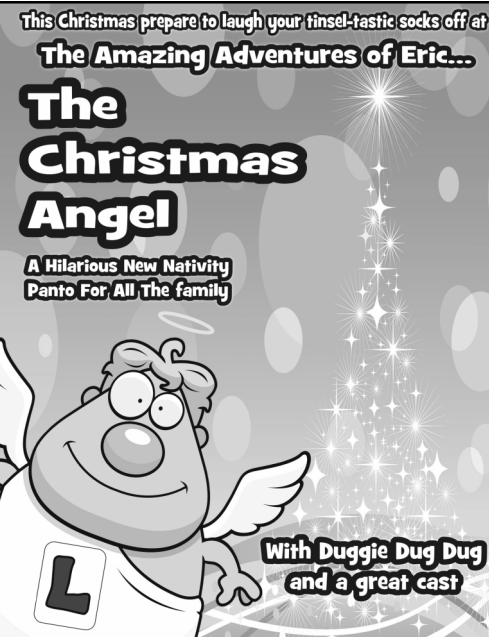
Festive Fun in Pennys Walk - Sat 25th Nov
