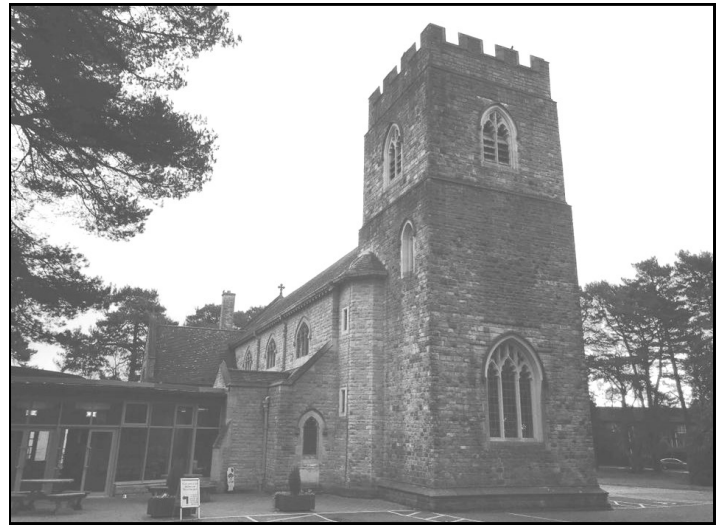

Saturday: Pray for the Venture camps being run by CPAS this summer. Pray that each person who attends will encounter Jesus, and that many will commit their lives to Him.

Sunday: 'Lift up your heads, you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in' (Ps. 24: 7). Prepare to exalt the King of glory!
