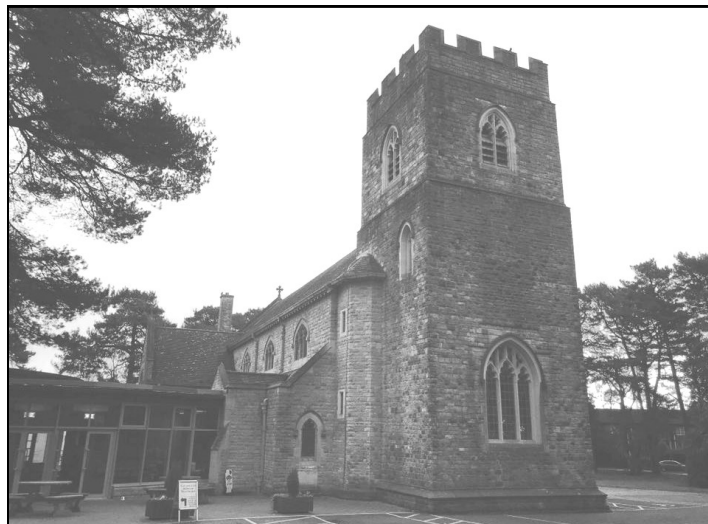

# Prayer Diary

**Monday:** As we begin daily prayer, ask that God will encourage each of us in our prayer lives. The disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray - let's ask the same for us, and ask Him to increase our faith and to give us a passion to connect with Him in prayer.

**Tuesday:** Pray for the PCC as they meet this evening. Pray for a sense of the Presence of God and that He will guide us in the way that we should go as a community of His people.

**Wednesday:** Pray for refugees and asylum seekers and all 'in a foreign land'. Pray particularly for those families separated at the US border and for a merciful, compassionate and just response to their situation.

**Thursday:** Pray for the leaders of our nation. Ask God to bless them and to give them wisdom. Pray for Christians serving in parliament and those acting as governmental advisers.

**Friday:** Pray for the Arrow Leadership programme run by CPAS for Christian leaders under 40. Pray that it will be growing leaders in Jesus-shaped leadership that inspires and blesses others.

**Saturday:** Pray for our prayer ministry team gathering today for teaching, prayer and practice.

**Sunday:** Pray for Christians in our town that we will grow in faith and love for God and others and that we will excel in the gifts of the Spirit which build up the church
