

Prayer Diary

Monday: 'The Kingdom of God is like a mustard seed which a man took and planted in his garden. It grew and became a tree, and the birds perched in its branches'. (Luke 13: 19). Prayer that the Kingdom of God would be growing and growing in Ferndown! Pray that many will come and take refuge in the Lord.

Tuesday: 'Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it' (Prov. 22: 6). Pray for MARS relationship skills training - pray for the team going into the Upper School today. Pray for all those who help to train children in Godly ways.

Wednesday: 'For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword' (2 Tim. 4: 12). Pray for the work of the Bible Society in bringing the Bible to those who haven't encountered it, both in the UK and abroad.

Thursday: 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things'. (Matt. 25: 23). Pray that we will be faithful with all that God has given us, so that we may be entrusted with more.

Friday: 'For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline'. (2 Tim. 1: 7). Pray for those that are fearful today, for an encounter with the Holy Spirit.

Saturday: 'After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly'. (Acts 4: 31). Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit that will shake us up and lead to a proclamation of the Good News!

Sunday: Blessed is the people of whom this is true; blessed is the people whose God is the Lord. (Ps. 144: 15). As we gather to celebrated Jesus, pray that we would know Him more as our Good Father.

PRAYER FOCUS

But when the kindness and love of God our Saviour appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Saviour, so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life'.
